Mr. Thompson's artistic expression began in elementary school, drawing cartoons, cars, and motorcycles for his classmates and nephews. Encouraged by his family and teachers throughout his schooling, he developed an awareness of and appreciation for various forms of media.

Gaylon was fortunate enough to study with Katherine Walker-Richardson, Bob Gerbracht from the Pastel Society of America, and a variety of other artists. In 2006 he was chosen to participate in an exhibition titled "100 Oklahoman Heroes and Outlaws by 100 Oklahoma Artists" for the Oklahoma State Centennial celebration. His painting of General Clarence Tinker, for whom Tinker AFB was named, now hangs at the headquarters on the base.
