# You are needed to help the Edmond Art Association be all it can be!

We currently have several positions on the board that are vacant, due to some members moving away, and others becoming unable to serve right now. Here is a description of the positions. Please read, and think about what ways you may be able to contribute to our group. The positions we need to have filled are Secretary, Fall/Spring Show Chairman, and Exhibition Chair.

The **Secretary** shall keep minutes of all meetings. The Secretary shall arrange for someone to photograph and record activities and events of the Association and preserve the archives of the Association.

The **Fall and Spring Show Chairman** has been combined. It is for a one year term with no limit on number of terms served. The show should organize a committee to oversee and execute jobs associated with the Fall or Spring Show, including booking a judge, producing prospectus, arranging awards, mailings, registration, set-up/breakdown, and check-in at location, hospitality, artist packets, evaluation, and any other job deemed necessary for the smooth operation and execution of the shows.

The **Exhibition Chair** organizes committee to oversee and locate potential places to display members' art such as hospitals, banks, art galleries, etc. Hannah previously held this position.
