Cindy Mason is a self-taught watercolor and acrylic painter who has studied with a number of notable artists Oklahoma and Texas. Her work has shown in regional exhibitions, group shows, traveling shows, and festivals. She has been accepted as a part of the Oklahoma City Pre-qualified Artist Pool for Projects under \$25,000. Her work has also been included in several publications.

Mason has been a professional artist for over thirty years. Starting in watercolor; Mason chose bold, clear colors with an impressionistic style. Then, approximately twenty years ago, she began working with acrylics.

About ten years ago, Mason began teaching with paint at two Michael Store locations. She discovered how much she enjoyed teaching and had the opportunity to lead classes at Chesapeake Energy as a part of their health and wellness program. Mason has also led classes at numerous Adult

Facilities that focus on needs of the visually impaired, emotional/mental needs, senior citizens and several youth programs as well. This past year Mason has begun a monthly Paseo Paint and Palette event.

Mason has been the juror of the OCCC Arts Fest of Oklahoma, the Hobart Arts Festival and the Yukon high school art show. Also, has judged the Sapulpa Arts Festival for four years.

Recently, Mason has developed a series of black and white paintings. "I have always loved charcoal drawings. One particular day I began wondering if I could use paint to have the same effect as my charcoal drawings. I have been very pleased and excited with the outcome. Not only does the paint have the same look as charcoal but I enjoy the moods I can express using just black and white paint." – Cindy Mason



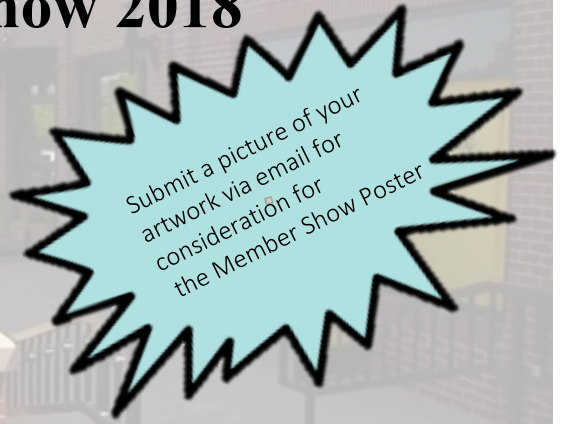
